Oxford Uehiro Prize in Practical Ethics

- Two papers from each category, graduate & undergraduate, will be shortlisted to go forward to a public presentation and discussion, to be held in 7th Week, Hilary Term 2017, where the winner of each category will be selected.
- The winner from each category will receive £300, and the runner up £100. All four finalist essays will be considered for publication in the *Journal of Practical Ethics*.
